- Strathmore Mixed Media Art Journal 11 x 14 --48 pages

- White Gesso for prepping page for acrylic painting (any brand)
- 4 oz tubes of Heavy Body Acrylic Paints: 1) mars black, 2) titanium white, 3) phthalocyanine blue, 4) Quinacridone magenta, 5) cadmium yellow--Liquitex Basics Acrylic, Golden, Artists Loft or other brands
- Drawing pencils of varying weights or just a writing pencil for sketching. Here is a set for \$5.99: <https://www.michaels.com/artists-loft-fundamentals-sketching-and-drawing-set/10125028.html>
- Charcoal stick or pencil
- Black markers: a thin and a thick
- Sketch pad or copy paper for sketching during class and doing preliminary sketches
- Kneaded eraser
- 1 inch flat brush
- 1/4 inch flat brush
- Round Brush
- Inexpensive 2 inch brush for Gesso: an old brush is fine- Gesso doesn't rinse out well
- Mixing pallet or plastic plates from the dollar store
- Jar for water (mugs and mason jars work well, plastic cups tend to get knocked over)
- Pad of solid colored paper (scrapbooking paper or construction paper- second semester)
- Matt Medium (second semester)
- Gold foil sheets or flakes (no glue necessary, we put it on wet paint)
- Something to protect your workspace like a tablecloth or posterboard
- Colored markers or pencils (any brand)
- tracing paper in a pad or on a roll
- Ruler -- 18 inch

Plastic container or box to keep all these supplies in. (Art stores have large flat boxes that work well.)
